Connecticut Avenue, N.W. Area Rehabilitation
PHASE III, from Dupont Circle to K Street

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The new Connecticut Avenue N.W. project is the third phase of a DDOT-sponsored streetscape upgrade program. The project encompasses an approximate 1 mile 4-lane corridor between Dupont Circle and K Street. The street, streetscape, and associated infrastructure improvements are scheduled to be completed by early 2015. The DDOT right-of-way to be improved includes the roadway, sidewalks and upgrades to street lights and utilities. Access will be provided to businesses during construction. Work will be coordinated closely with WMATA to make sure access is maintained at all bus stops and metro stations. Located in the Golden Triangle BID, one of the prominent commercial and business corridors within the District, the project's effects on the area will be closely monitored with daily outreach to area businesses and citizens to be sure that construction efforts are well-planned and as least disruptive as possible.

PROJECT FEATURES

- Street resurfacing
- Replacement of deteriorated sidewalks with new block concrete paver sidewalks with ADA compliant curb-cut ramps, brick gutters, and granite curbs
- Geometric and safety improvements at intersections
- New bus pads at WMATA bus stops
- Replacement of driveway and alley entrances
- Streetscaping enhancements
- Installation of a new electrical duct bank system and upgraded storm drainage inlets, storm sewer pipes, and fire hydrants
- New Teardrop and Washington Globe street lights
- Installation of centralized parking meters
- New traffic signs and pavement markings
- Traffic signal replacements

CONSTRUCTION FACTS

The contractor will be allowed to work 7:00 am to 7:00 pm Monday through Friday. Work may be permitted beyond these times with prior notice and approval. A 72-hour notification will be provided to businesses, residences and stakeholders in this corridor prior to impacts on traffic flow and parking. At least one-lane of traffic in each direction, and access to businesses on the corridor, will be maintained at all times.
